

# Additional staff at no cost\*



Greenbank Employment Services are 1 of 5 providers chosen by Liverpool City Council to deliver the Future Jobs Fund Programme which is funded by City Employment Strategy Partnership, the Department for Work and Pensions and Liverpool City Council in partnership with Jobcentre Plus. FJF offers Liverpool based employers an opportunity to increase their workforce without increasing costs. In summary FJF offers:

- An employee at no cost for 26 weeks\*
- Free training and support for the participant
- Financial incentive to employ the participant at the end of the 26 week 'trial'
- Free promotion of vacancy through Greenbank's website and Jobcentre Plus network
- The option to interview the participant before appointment

## Opportunities must be:

- Newly created and not replace existing staff
- For a minimum of 25 hours per week
- Offered at National Minimum Wage, however, the work placement hosts can top this up at their discretion
- Of benefit to local communities and encourage social inclusion

Future Jobs Fund (FJF) is delivered by Greenbank Employment Services and funded by City Employment Strategy Partnership, the Department for Work and Pensions and Liverpool City Council in partnership with Jobcentre Plus. FJF offers participants\*:

- At least 25 hours per week paid work at minimum wage or above for 26 weeks
- Induction to programme
- Careers advice
- Action planning and goal setting
- Criminal Record Bureau checks
- Additional help from support agencies
- Assistance of a job coach
- Training\*\*
